



The New East Photo Prize Terms and Conditions 2018

Submissions for the New East Photo Prize are open from Friday 16 March to midnight (GMT) Friday 15 June 2018. The shortlisted works will be exhibited at Calvert 22 Space in London from October–November 2018. The winner of the New East Photo Prize will receive a £1,000 grant alongside having work featured in the above mentioned exhibition and benefiting from international exposure as well as feedback from industry experts. The winner of the Fabrika Travel Photography Prize will receive a five-day trip to Georgia where they will visit Tbilisi and Kazbegi with official partners Rooms Hotel and Fabrika. The winner of the Metro Imaging Mentorship Award will receive a tailored mentorship programme to suit the needs of the artist, who will be fully supported over a 12-month period and receive £1,000 credit with Metro Imaging.

1. Entry is open to citizens of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Georgia, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan, aged 18 years or over, except for employees of Calvert 22 Foundation. Citizens of the above stated countries residing anywhere in the world are eligible for entry.
2. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. Entries should be submitted via the electronic submission form on the New East Photo Prize's official web page: <http://calvert22.org/new-east-photo-prize-2018/>. Entrants should include their own name, address, and telephone number and a short biographical note (up to 200 words long).
4. Photography entries shot on either film or digital cameras are eligible. However, all images submitted must be in digital file format.
5. Entry is free of charge and is open to both professional and amateur photographers.
6. Entrants can submit a photography project made within the last two years. Each submission must be accompanied by a photographic statement of up to 600 words long. Entrants can submit up to 15 (fifteen) photos.
7. Each image should be at least 72 dpi and between 1MB–3MB, in RGB mode, JPEG in maximum quality.
8. All images submitted must be that of your or your collective/group's work and you must own the copyright for them. It is your responsibility to ensure that any images you submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.
9. Only one entry per person. Late entries will not be accepted.
10. Copyright and all other rights remain that of the photographer. Any photograph used by Calvert 22 Foundation shall carry the photographer's credit line. Use may include publication in any Calvert 22 Foundation media partner publication.

11. All entrants understand that any image submitted to the competition may be used by Calvert 22 Foundation for marketing and promotional purposes including in any media such as exhibitions, print and digital media directly related to the New East Photo Prize. By winning or participating in the competition you are agreeing to be included in print publications.
12. Neither the New East Photo Prize, Calvert 22 Foundation nor their associates, affiliates, or partners assume any responsibility for photos submitted in violation of prize rules, or for those which violate copyright regulations.
13. Judging of the main prize will consist of three rounds:
 - Round 1 – The Longlist: The Creative Director and Editors from *The Calvert Journal* will select the longlist of works by Friday 13 July 2018.
 - Round 2 – The Shortlist: The jury panel will select a shortlist of artists by Friday 17 August 2018. The shortlist will be announced publicly on Monday 3 September 2018 and the shortlisted works will be shown at the New East Photo Prize exhibition at Calvert 22 Space from October–November 2018.
 - Round 3 – The Winner: The judges will select a winner who will be announced on 1 November 2018.
14. The winner of the Fabrika Travel Photography Prize is dedicated to the project that best documents the landscape, culture, people or history of a region or place and will be selected by the editorial team of Fabrika Tbilisi. It will be announced in November 2018. The winner will receive a five-day trip to Georgia, staying in Fabrika Tbilisi and Rooms Hotel Kazbegi, with tours of the capital and the mountains. This prize is from our partners Fabrika, the hostel and urban hotspot in Tbilisi.
15. The winner of the Metro Mentorship will receive support over a twelve-month period and a £1,000 production credit with Metro Imaging. The mentorship is tailored to meet the needs of the individual. Metro Imaging will work with the winner to identify areas in their practice that require development, including technical experience, networking opportunities, access to industry professionals, and professional and business development.
16. The shortlisted entrants will be notified by email in late August 2018.
17. The judges will select work based on artistic merit. The jury's decision is final and will be published on the official website of the New East Photo Prize. The organiser will not enter into any correspondence regarding the selection of the New East Photo Prize exhibition.
18. The winners may be required to take part in publicity activities.
19. English law applies and the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts shall prevail.
