



JOB DESCRIPTION – WEB DESIGNER/DEVELOPER

Job title: Web Designer/Developer

Summary

The role of the Web Designer/Developer is being responsible for the design, and programming of the organisation's websites including special projects and features. Working across the organisation, with various teams, being the key person involved with some technical UI and UX aspects to the sites in terms of how it works and how it looks, and will also be responsible for regular maintenance and continuous testing as features might change.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- Ability to draw up detailed website specifications and practice the style guides of the organisation's foundational design elements.
- Identify needs of the organisation in terms of user interfaces features.
 - o Determine any functionality that the site must support (for ex. financial transactions or enquiries).
- Experience of working with different content management systems. (e.g. WordPress and Expression Engine).
- Ability to code effectively (minimal and optimised), either from scratch or by adapting existing website code and to meet our companies goals.
- Familiar with version control software. (GitHub and Beanstalk etc).
- Ability to debug effectively and identify any bugs that's breaking the site.
- Awareness of legal requirements such as accessibility standards, freedom of information and privacy.
- Experience of registering web domain names and organising the hosting of the website.

- A creative and imaginative mind and ability to translate the creativity to practical solutions due to skills in programming and design thinking.



- Good team player and communicator with the ability to effectively take direction as well as direct.
- Being adaptable and able to pick up new techniques.
